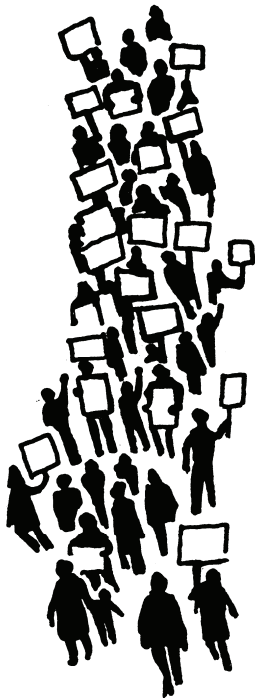


# The University of California Board of Regents are meeting at UCSF's Mission Bay facility November 15th, 16th and 17th.



## ReFund the University of California

At the November UC Regents meeting budget analysts will propose \$2.5 billion in new “trigger cuts” to public education. UC’s president has proposed more job cuts and up to 81% in tuition hikes to cover the shortfall.

- ▶ Reverse the proposed cuts to employee retirement benefits, layoff and tuition hikes.
- ▶ Publicly support forthcoming ballot initiatives and legislation to increase taxes on California’s super rich and corporations.
